Aurelia F. Brewer, 76, of Monroe, formerly of Cleveland, Tennessee, went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, November 15, 2018, at the IHM Senior Living Community.

Born November 16, 1941 in Mount Vernon, Texas, she was the daughter of the late Benonia S. and Stella A. (Ledbetter) Hargrave. Aurelia married Rev. J. Ralph Brewer on June 28, 1958 in Simpsonville, South Carolina. Sadly, he preceded her in death on September 12, 2011.
